## Media and Information Literacy in the Age of Global Crisis and Confrontations

The polarization of society and the growing distrust of some citizens towards democratic values and principles can be linked to media and information literacy. This panel will address if this literacy is a suitable tool for increasing resilience to hybrid threats, sophisticated disinformation and propaganda strategies. Speakers will also analyse the connection between media education and tools like algorithms and artificial intelligence, especially in social media. Within social media, they will discuss the use of behavioural and data science to attract the audiences' attention to spread disinformation. These topics raise the question of how to combine knowledge of digital tools with practical skills like critical thinking to build citizens' resilience to the ever-changing economic, social and cultural conditions in which we live.
